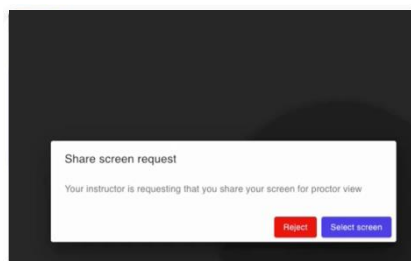


Your instructor may start a Proctor Session during assessments or independent work. Here's exactly what will happen and what you need to do.

① What Happens When Proctor View Starts

1 You get a request

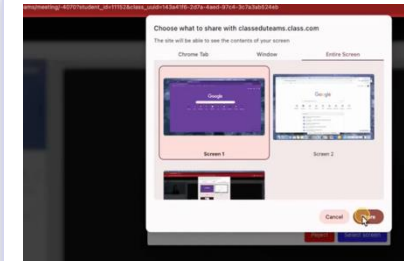
A screen-share request pops up. You must accept for proctoring to take place.



Accept share screen request

2 Choose your screen

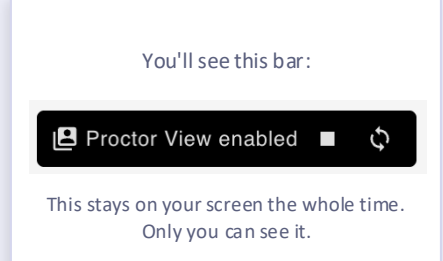
If you have multiple monitors, allow window management, then select your monitor(s) and click Share



Select each screen and share

3 You're in — carry on!

A small "Proctor View enabled" bar appears. Nothing else on your screen changes.



② On a Mac? Grant Screen Recording Permission First

If Class can't see your screen, your Mac may be blocking screen recording. Fix it in under a minute:



💡 After toggling on Chrome or Edge, **restart the browser completely** for the change to take effect. Then re-join your Class session.

③ Stopping & What You Can (and Can't) See

How to stop sharing

- Click the ■ stop button in your Proctor View bar, OR
- Wait — your instructor ends it for everyone, OR
- Your instructor clicks ✕ on your tile to stop just yours.
